Diagnostics/Imaging

Cancer can be difficult to detect, but the earlier it is detected, the better the chance of a positive outcome. The Cancer Institute utilizes the latest diagnostic and imaging technology to not only detect cancer but also to stage and locate it to direct surgery and treatments and to monitor response to therapy.

We continuously update, upgrade and acquire new technology that is safer, faster and better.





Cancer treatment plans are coordinated by a whole team of oncology specialists and are developed specifically for each patient.

Radiation Therapy

Our radiation oncologists are focused on treating cancer and have the expertise, experience and advanced radiation treatment technology to beat it.



TruBeam Radiation Therapy System

Designed to treat with speed and accuracy and can treat cancer most anywhere in the body where radiation treatment is indicated

Brainlab's ExacTrac

Calculates patient movement with sub-millimetric precision for accuracy and patient safety during treatment

RapidArc Radiation Therapy

Delivers a highly focused beam of radiation directly to the tumor in less than two minutes from nearly any angle, resulting in less damage to surrounding healthy tissue

Brachytherapy

Treats cancer from the inside, conforming the radiation to the size and shape of the tumor, limiting damage to surrounding healthy anatomy

Our cancer experts understand the anxiety that accompanies a cancer diagnosis. For the convenience and comfort of our patients, we offer next-day appointments and a spa-inspired lounge, including a changing area for patients while undergoing treatments.


Infusion Suite

The infusion suite can provide chemotherapy and immunotherapy service for up to 44 patients at a time. There are six private suites with video monitoring as well as an outdoor terrace option where patients can receive treatment when the weather is nice. The infusion suite is staffed with specially trained nurses to guide patients and families through their specific treatment plans.

Medical Oncology Clinic

In our Medical Oncology Clinic, we have more cancer doctors to treat more types of cancer. Treatment plans are developed by a team of experts, specific for each patient, and our oncologists collaborate with surgeons, radiologists, pathologists and other specialists. Designed with 26 exam rooms and four triage areas for efficient flow, the Clinic also has space dedicated for visiting specialists.





Laboratory and Pharmacy

Inside the Cancer Institute are convenient specialized services such as a lab for blood work and a pharmacy.

Activity Center

Cancer treatment and wellness are integrated with patients benefiting physically and emotionally from yoga, art therapy, nutrition education and more.






Chapel
